Only 20% chance of achieving 5 good pass grades

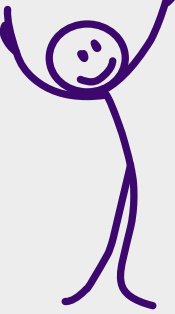
